RULES & REGS:

You're about to embark on a journey that will teach you a lot about Hoboken, it's history, ecology, and, of course, it's honorary bird. Each site participating in the parade & scavenger hunt includes at least two answers:

- One found on decoys pertaining to <u>Feathered</u> <u>Facts</u> about Hoboken's Common Tern
- Another is located somewhere on their premises, known as <u>Business Brainteasers</u> asking you to use your Eagle Eyes to find things hiding in plain sight.
- We've included some fun items to help you watch Hoboken like a Hawk, known as <u>Our City</u> <u>Stumpers</u>, as you make your way from place to place.

There are a few organizations not in the scavenger hunt, and you'll need to keep an eye out for their Tern decoys too because they can help you accumulate points.

Please be kind and respectful at all stops to help us show our graTERNtude for making the Parade possible!







IT'S YOUR TERN, SO YOU DECIDE HOW YOU WANT TO COMPLETE THE TASKS.

Your goal is to amass as many points as you can. There are a lot of tasks, so don't be overwhelmed or feel expected to get everything done in a day. We have indicated how many points each question/ task is worth. How you play is up to you. Depending upon the day or time you hunt, various organizations may be open or closed, so there is an element of chance that makes this journey even more exciting. You and your flock can compete with each other by flying through Hoboken in one day, or you can take your time and see and learn over several weeks.

(The Scavenger hunt will operate from Thursday 4/10-Sunday 6/1). Want to check your answers? Stop by the library to speak with a specially trained Passport Agent who can confirm your answers, or request an answer key (a sealed envelope with the answers) that your group leader can use at the end of your journey.



So what are you waiting for? It's Your Tern to Hunt! Happy exploring, & may the best vulture soar to victory! (Vultures are the scavengers of the bird world)

GAME MODES

- Mighty Migration: Break up into teams. Agree upon a set time (1 hour, 4 hours, etc). Begin and end at agreed upon locations. Whoever earns the most points in the agreed upon time wins. Teams need to stay together at every location in order to earn points!
- Flock Fun: Meet up with some friends or family and make your way through Hoboken as you check off items in the passport. See how many places you can visit in a day.
- An Egg-ellent Idea: Assign different members of your group to different locations. Establish an agreed upon meet-up space and time. Share what each person/pair learned and see if you can fill in the entire passport while you reflect on your fun times exploring.
- Slow & Steady Goose: Pick up a passport and treat it like a checklist. Perfect for a solo tour or multiple meet-ups with someone you love. Meander and mark up your passport. Be sure to visit every spot by June 1 so you see and savor it all.
- Wing It: Come up with your own way to explore. Just make sure you learn a ton and have fun!


